# CCA Updates – Background and Timelines

- We have been working for some time on version 2.0 of the Carequality Connected Agreement (CCA)
- We put forward a proposed version 2.0 for final objections in March
- Three Implementers did raise objections
- We have made further revisions to address these objections, after consultation with the objecting parties and the community as a whole
- The updated version 2.0 is currently out for final objections, which must be registered by 11:59pm PDT **TODAY**
- In the absence of significant objection, the new version will go into effect on September 30th

# FHIR Policy Workgroup Update

- The first 1st draft of Policy Implementation Guide Outline is available here:

- Our weekly meetings currently consist of working sessions whereby we are actively reviewing comments/feedback submitted by the group, and making any necessary updates to the document
- This will continue for approximately the next month
- After this, we will determine what the next steps are

# Query-Based Doc Exchange Enhancements

- A draft redline is being reviewed by the workgroup
- The core areas of focus were to create or update:
  - An operational approach for verifying compliance with any document content requirements
  - A method to process any accusations of noncompliance from other Implementers, including communications processes to provide awareness of the situation for affected organizations
  - Updates to the Query-Based Document Exchange Implementation Guide based on the recommendations of the Advancing Patient Queries Working Group
- Additionally, we were authorized to examine:
  - Evaluation of the current required reporting measures to determine if any changes should be made in the form of policy updates
  - Policy updates in support of Operations, Coverage, and potentially Payment queries.

# Push Notifications Workgroups

- Current discussion topics
  - Technical Workgroup
    - Technical approaches to subscriptions and notifications
    - Notification System Design
    - Considering how and if we will align with Argonaut and Davinci Project where appropriate. We have had presentations from both groups to provide details on their work to date
  - Policy Workgroup
    - Notifications Content
      - Determining the specific payload based on the notification type
    - Notification Triggering Events and Definitions

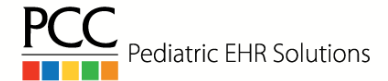
