

Technical Trust Policy

- The Steering Committee formally adopted the updated Technical Trust Policy during its August 5, 2021 meeting and it was officially published the following day
- Most of the changes in this document relate to DirectTrust becoming the new Certificate Authority
 - No <u>new</u> changes to any Carequality implementation are required

CA Update

- Statistics (as of Aug 25):
- Issued 249 new Certs since project kick-off
- Issued 77 Certs in August
- There are an additional 42 Cert requests in flight
- For those who participate in both Carequality/eHX, we're simultaneously attempting to secure both Certs in one email, regardless of when either Cert expires
- This is really speeding up the process and we're on target for sunsetting Entrust (our current CA) by Nov 1st

Policy Workgroup Update

- An ongoing goal of the workgroup is to increase participation and response to purposes outside of treatment
- Now focused specifically on Payment and Healthcare Operations
- In order to get a better sense of where we currently stand, we have to consider:
 - Which parts of payment and operations do we want to use?
 - What are the use cases?
 - What kind of organizations would likely to use them?
 - Which Implementers/CCs are using this today?
- Once identified, we can build community trust by determining the evidence these organizations need to submit to CEQ in support of their use of these nontreatment purposes


