

FHIR Workgroup Update

- We discovered that in FHIR Based Exchange, the number of Implementers that require only I certificate to support the entirety of their participation in the Use Case is much less than what we see in Document Exchange
- In FHIR, instead of certificates being (mostly) required at the gateway level, we're finding more and more Implementers expressing a certificate need at the site or client/server level
- This means we'll need a significantly larger number of certificates to manage the ecosystem
- To combat this problem, the workgroup has outlined 2 solutions that will make their way into V2 of the FHIR Based Exchange IG



FHIR Workgroup Update

- We'll expand the use of the Subject Alternative Name (SAN) to help identify "unique clients" for those Implementers that require this functionality as it relates to the Purpose of Use being expressed in the query
- 2. Implementers that require a large number of certificates (greater than 100), we will given the opportunity to create their own Certificate Authorities (CAs) for managing certificates within their networks
 - These entities would be given a seed certificate that would be used for creating certificates for their network
 - This would be chained back to the CEQ seed, which in turn, is chained back to the CEQ root certificate
 - We are not breaking new ground here as large Implementers like CommonWell and Epic have already successfully deployed this CA model

Image Exchange Update

- Last month, our most active Imaging vendors (Philips and Hyland) were supposed to have a Connectathon to test updated code against a SAML issue discovered earlier in the year
- However, due to some re-orgs and a number key employees involved in this effort shifting roles / leaving the company, this project is now in a holding pattern
- Thankfully, another vendor (Nuance), has recently become more engaged and they could be ready to help advance this effort next month
- Separately, Carequality is meeting with some large provider orgs (who use the Imaging vendors software.) And we're exploring ways to leverage their voices to help move the needle for creating an Imaging Exchange ecosystem

- Not all Implementers are required to participate in testing at this time. But we wanted to specifically call out the Test Ecosystem referenced in section 6.2.3 of the QBDE IG
 - If any development work is needed to get you ready for R4, this requirement will be enforced for the end of 2022
 - More details around the Test Ecosystem will be distributed as they become available
