FHIR IG Workgroup Update

- The workgroup is wrapping up some final edits to create a new version (V2) of the FHIR IG
- We are also following up regarding extremely large
 Implementers (who may need thousands of Certs) having the
 capability to act as their own CA. Ideally, after getting an
 intermediate certificate from one of the DirectTrust certified
 CA's, Implementers can then distribute certificates to their
 clients based upon that Cert. This allows the Cert issuance
 process to scale as opposed to being unsustainable
- However. Concern has been raised about our plan and we
 want to be 100% certain that the "Trusted Framework"
 remains true to form. We continue to meet with internal and
 external stakeholders about this issue with an eye on arriving
 at a solution that also works for the QHIN Technical
 Framework (QTF). We hope to have this wrapped up in the
 next couple of weeks

Image Exchange Update

- We continue to be in a holding pattern for partner testing as we wait for some of the imaging vendors to hash out re-orgs and get their respective Gateways reading for testing
- Hyland continues to explore the possibility of going live by themselves
- This would allow their client base to exchange images with other Hyland customers; a capability they currently do <u>not</u> have
- To this end, Hyland has committed Development resources towards the required Directory piece (their Gateway build is complete.) To be clear, this piece is tied to the R4 version of the Directory being available

FHIR R4 Directory Update

- We've given R4 Dev Directory access to a number of Implementers to test out the new Directory Implementation Guide
- Initial feedback was very limited as most Implementers were confused by the new Directory IG
- There's been a lot of new activity the last few weeks as we continued the feedback loop throughout the month of August
- We'll figure out next steps/timelines for migrating to R4 as we complete our review sometime in September and react to any necessary changes

- The Tiger Team has completed its work and has identified the technical requirements needed for this new type of CC, which will be 'rolled in' to the new R4 Directory
 - o Add an "OBO" value to the Initiator Only code set
 - Add an "OBO" FHIR Extension type Identifier. This more aligned with true FHIR customizations and was unanimously approved by the Tiger Team

- We ran a Straw Proposal by the Advisory Council earlier this month and will be chatting with the Steering Committee next about officially rolling out this new functionality
