2022 Annual Meeting: Unconference Sessions

FHIR IG Update

- The workgroup wrapped up its work months ago and V2 of the IG is 99% complete. However – we are still addressing concerns raised around the proposed solution for managing the large number of certificates needed to support a FHIR ecosystem
- We continue to review feedback we requested on the TEFCA FHIR IG (as it relates to certificates) and crafting a design that works for the both TEFCA and Carequality
- We hope to have final resolution for the certificates/CA issue soon

Image Exchange Update

- Two imaging vendors are actively testing towards becoming live Implementors
- They are also working on their Directory solutions, which must be utilized before going live (in Production)
 - This is also contingent on them using the FHIR R4 Directory
- Numerous provider orgs in California are meeting regularly to discuss the possibility of joining our image exchange efforts

FHIR R4 Directory - Update

- We are working internally on next steps and timelines for migrating to the R4 Directory
- On the last Technical Forum call, we stressed the level of effort needed for this migration, especially around the backfill of new metadata(NPI, PoU, etc) that will exist in the new Directory
 - We are getting feedback from the Implementers on these backfills to help shape our timelines
